

TNEA Eligibility Criteria 2020: Qualifying Exams

Candidates are eligible to apply for TNEA if they have cleared their HSC (academic) or its equivalent with a minimum average percentage in Mathematics, Physics and Chemistry put together as mentioned below:

Community	Pass with minimum average marks in Maths, Physics & Chemistry put together
General Category	45%
Backward Class including Backward Class Muslim	40%
MBC and DNC	40%
SC/ST/SCA	40%

Apart from the above mentioned eligibility criteria, candidates will also be eligible for admissions if they have cleared any one of the HSC (Vocational Subject) as mentioned below with one of the Engineering related subjects namely Mathematics, Physics or Chemistry with a minimum average percentage put together as mentioned below:

Community	Pass with minimum average marks in related subjects, vocational theory and practical put together
General Category	45%
Backward Class including Backward Class Muslim	40%
MBC and DNC	40%
SC/ST/SCA	40%
